

Bulwell Library to get a garden makeover

Sprout, an environmental project run by the Partnership Council charity in Hyson Green, is joining forces with local residents, Bulwell Library Garden Group, Nottingham City Council, The Big Spring Clean and Bulwell Library to transform the garden at Bulwell Library- at a community gardening event on Friday 29th May from 12 noon till 4pm.

Sprout has held several successful community gardening days around Nottingham and has recently improved the garden at Hyson Green Library, with the help of local people and employee volunteers from Nottingham company UPS.

Jabran Ahmed from the Partnership Council explains:

“Community gardening events are a great opportunity for young people and people from the local community to volunteer in their local area, especially if you’d prefer to volunteer at a one-off event. The good thing is, volunteers and local residents can see the difference they’re making straight away and can enjoy the fruits of their labour every day- in this case, when they visit or walk past the Bulwell Library.

Plus of course, our community gardening days are a good place to pick up useful gardening hints and tips and enjoy the sunshine!”

Volunteers will be clearing rubbish and unwanted plants, weeding, mowing the grass and planting new flowers in the grounds around the library.

Sprout was set up by the Partnership Council in January 2008 to support young people’s environmental projects. In addition, Sprout organises regular events to get people- especially young people- involved in volunteering and caring for the local environment.
